AREAS OF RESPONSIBILITIES

Key Tasks

- To lead the County 1st team in Inter-county matches
- Work with the SLCGA Association Executive Committee to fix a workable schedule of dates for coaching and matches.
- The Captain is ultimately responsible for team selection after discussion with the Vice Captain, President and Coaches and using the criteria for selection as agreed by the Executive committee and published on SLCGA website. The team to be announced after the County Championships.
- To attend County meetings and to present a report to the delegates at the General meeting. In the absence of the President, the Captain will chair the meetings.
- To work in close liaison with the CJO and to attend as many Junior events as possible during the year.

QUALIFICATIONS

Good standard of golf, experience and, if possible, some prior knowledge of County administration.

PERSON SPECIFICATION

Good communication skills.

Free time which is flexible.

Be available to spend time away from home for more than one day.

Ability to use information technology is essential

Provide data for the Criminal Records Bureau.

SELECTION PROCESS Appointed by the County Executive Committee

TERM OF OFFICE Two years after having spent two years as Vice Captain.

This should be set by the County Committee. England Golf recommends a limit of 10 years.

EXPENSES

The County will reimburse the County Captain for travel, and will pay for food and accommodation for Matches. There is also an honorarium of £250 for incidental expenses
